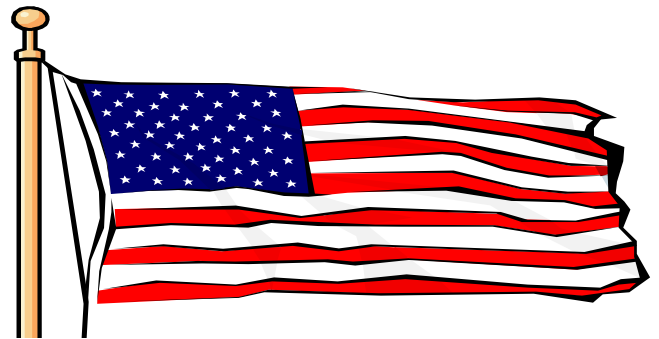

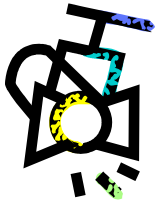

Everyone is invited to attend the Dedication Ceremony for the Walden Veterans Memorial Park on Flag Day, Sunday, June 14 at 1 pm which is sponsored by the Walden Community Council Walden Veterans Memorial Park Council. The Park is located on the west side of the Walden Veterans Memorial Bridge. Congressman Maurice Hinchey will present an American flag that has flown over the White House in honor of our veterans at this event.
